

Hiring an Architect

You may have seen the posting in our local newspapers requesting proposals for architectural services for the Louise Marshall Hospital expansion. The last date to submit a proposal is July 20th, 2012.

Timelines

The Louise Marshall Hospital expansion will take two years to plan and the hope is to begin tendering in 2014/15 with construction to follow.

When people hear the word “campus” most think of a college or university.

The Louise Marshall Hospital expansion will be built on a “campus of care” model, a single location with a range of health care services available, all surrounding and focusing on patients and families.

The Louise Marshall Emergency Room and Ambulatory care hospital expansion will be aligned with our local family health team including Physician offices, long-term care services and other health care providers. The expansion will further support integration with services and facilities through some shared

space as well as partnerships and technology ensuring patient care is provided in the right place, at the right time by the right person.

North Wellington Health Care has over the years developed extensive partnerships with other providers of health services including our local Family Health Teams, Family Physicians, Trellis Mental Health, Community Care Access Centres and Midwifery Groups. With the hospital renovations we will continue to strengthen these relationships and attract new health care partners.
